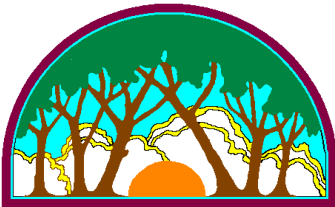


About Moses Merrill Camp and Conference Center

Driving Directions

From Omaha: Take Hwy. 275 north to Fremont, then Hwy. 30. Take Hwy. 30 west to North Bend. At North Bend, take Hwy. 79 south two miles to Morse Bluff. At Morse Bluff, take Linwood Road (a gravel county road) west about six miles to Road 31. MMCCC is on your left.

From Lincoln: Take Hwy. 34 West to Hwy. 79. Continue on Hwy. 79 north to Morse Bluff. At Morse Bluff, take Linwood Road (a gravel county road) west about six miles to Road 31. MMCCC is on your left.

From Grand Island/Columbus: Take Hwy 30 east to Schuyler. At Schuyler, drive south on Hwy. 15 approximately two miles to Spur 12A. At Spur 12A, drive east to Linwood. Watch for signs at Linwood. Follow Linwood Road/Road 47 (a gravel county road) for three miles. MMCCC is on your right.

From Norfolk: Take Hwy 275 east to Pilger. Then follow Hwy. 15 south to Schuyler. At Schuyler, continue south on Hwy. 15 approximately 2 miles to Spur 12A. At Spur 12A, drive east to Linwood. At Linwood, follow Linwood Road/Road 47 (a gravel county road) for three miles to Road 31. MMCCC is on your right.

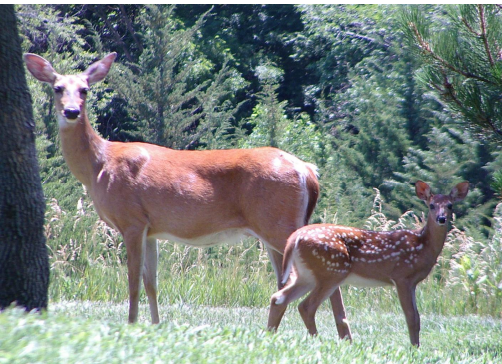

Our RV Loop is located in a tranquil valley on Nash Valley Road where shade trees, fresh air, and wildlife abound. Water, sewer, and 30 amp electrical hookups are available at 22 sites, accommodating trailers up to 30 feet in length. Additional sites offer water and electrical hookups with access to a nearby bathhouse complete with showers. Tenting sites are also available.
